Choosing a pistol or revolver for concealed carry is a very personal decision. No self-respecting firearms instructor should ever tell you which gun you must carry. The choice is yours and yours alone, and it should only be made after much study and careful consideration of your needs and lifestyle.

To that end, we at *Concealed Carry Magazine* continually offer up facts and insight into handguns currently on the market. We can tell you what works and how it works, but we can't tell you if it will fit your hand, be comfortable on your hip, or how you will react to the recoil. All of that is up to you.

Below are 15 sidearms that we have found to be effective and capable for use as everyday defensive guns. This is not a complete list of appropriate options, but merely a representative sample. We have included technical specifications from the manufacturers and a short paragraph or two about the features and benefits we and others find interesting about these handguns.

The firearms listed here are presented in no particular order. All will work for you when your

life is on the line. The gun is simply a tool - your willingness to seek out training and hone the skills needed to defend yourself will have a far bigger impact in your personal defense plan than will the selection of a firearm. But the firearm is important.

The reason the firearm is so important is that in order for your training to be of any value, you must have with you when you need them the tools to implement that training. That means you need to pick out a firearm you will carry with you every day. Your firearm must be one that is comfortable to fire so that you will not find an excuse to avoid training. It must be of a type and style that encourages you to become familiar with its operation and maintenance. Above all, you must feel completely comfortable with your defensive firearm. This means, as I said at the beginning, selecting a firearm is a very personal choice. I encourage you to try as many pistols as you possibly can before making your decision.

What we give you with this list is a good place to start. You can see the technical data and read a little bit about each gun. The rest is up to you.



KAHR P380

Extrremely thin, lightweight, and almost miniscule, the P380 pistol from Kahr, chambered for the .380 ACP caliber, is a high-quality, striker-fired gun that's easy to carry and shoot, comfortably fitting even the smallest hands and frames. Holding 6 rounds in its magazine plus one round chambered, this pocket pistol is safe to carry with a chambered round, especially when you consider its long, 5.25-pound trigger pull. The easy-to-use sights are an added bonus to this ideal, concealed-carry pistol that's perfect for someone who wants to defend herself but still remain discreet.

S&W SHIELD

The Shield is the single-stack addition to the M&P line from Smith & Wesson. The pistol was released to great fanfare with a large marketing campaign and by all accounts has lived up to the hype. With a polymer frame and striker-fired action it has all the earmarks of a modern fighting pistol. Unlike other members of the M&P line, the Shield does not offer interchangeable handgrips, but can be had with an extended magazine to give an additional round.

WALTHER PPS

Walther has a long history of making slim, concealable defensive pistols and the PPS just keeps adding to that legacy. This striker-fired pistol comes in both 9mm and .40 S&W and offers a variety of magazine lengths, moving the 9mm capacity from 6 to 8 rounds. At less than an inch wide, this is a true carry pistol built for concealment.

Fit and finish are what you would expect from Walther and the ergonomics are outstanding. One thing to consider with this pistol is the location on the magazine release. Instead of the traditional button behind the trigger, the Walther PPS release is a small lever integral with the bottom of the trigger guard. It's not an issue unless you don't know where to look for it.

BERETTA NANO

This is the polymer pocket pistol from Beretta. Solid and well-built, the Nano is made for concealment and close-range work, yet it still sports decent three-dot sights. It is a bit heavier than some small pocket pistols, but the weight is not intolerable during all-day carry. With a sight radius of almost 5 inches, this pistol is still capable of excellent accuracy.

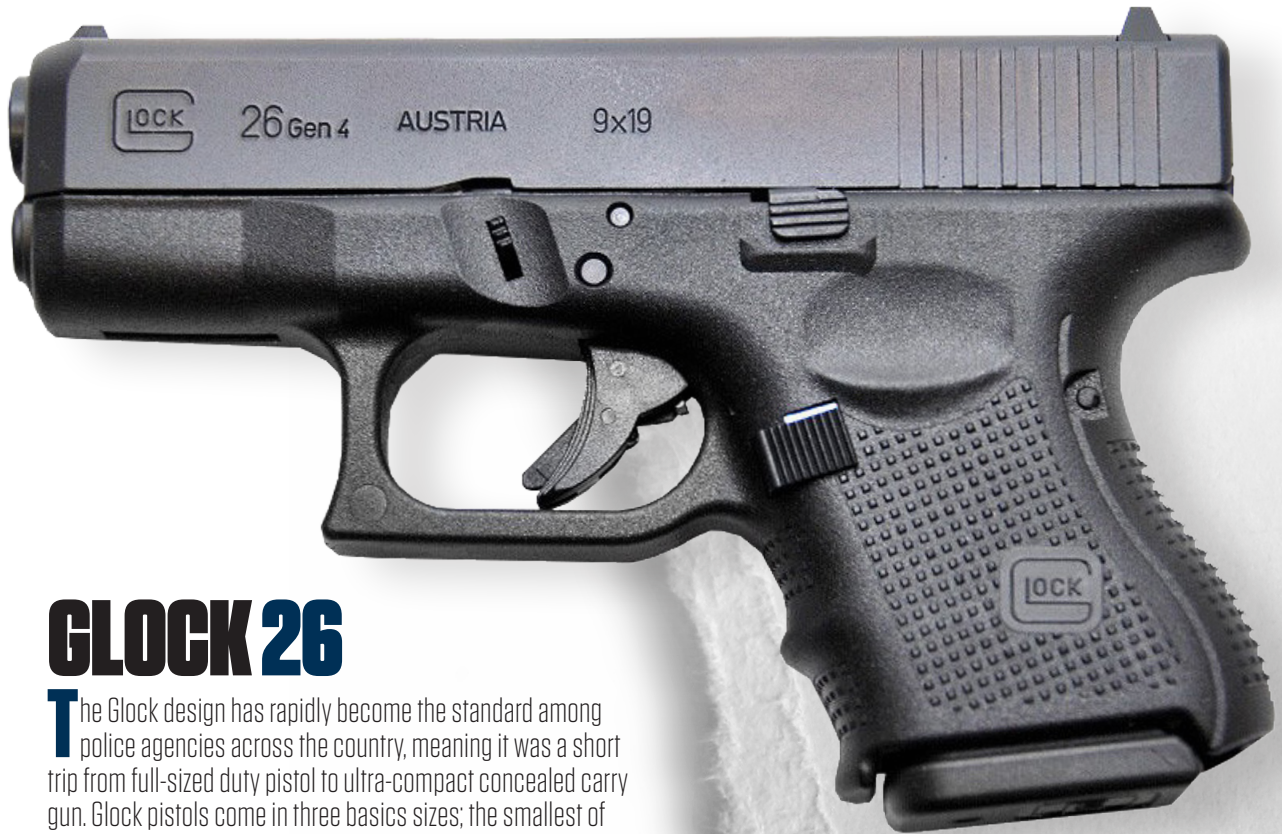


KIMBER SOLO

This little striker-fired Kimber comes in four different models to meet the demands of every shooter. This is a slim-line pocket pistol with all the great features and craftsmanship common to Kimber products. Well-built and ready for action, it is a small gun that nearly disappears when concealed. The Kimpro finish makes it nearly impervious to the elements.

GLOCK 26

The Glock design has rapidly become the standard among police agencies across the country, meaning it was a short trip from full-sized duty pistol to ultra-compact concealed carry gun. Glock pistols come in three basic sizes; the smallest of these is commonly called the Baby Glock and comes in all the standard calibers. Specifications shown here are for the 9mm. Other calibers will vary slightly.

The Glock is a simple, robust and supremely reliable design. The polymer frame makes the pistols lightweight and durable, while the patented Tenifer coating on the steel parts makes the pistols nearly maintenance-free. With its record of proven reliability the Glock pistol regardless of size and caliber has become a favorite among those who carry concealed.

The Millennium is often overlooked but sports a host of features not found on other pistols this size (and especially not in this price range.) This little double-stack gun holds 12 rounds in the magazine and includes a great double/single-action trigger system that allows for second strike capability. It also sports a frame-mounted manual safety. Ergonomics are excellent for a small carry pistol.

SIG P238

Sig's P238 is a solid entry into the pocket pistol market. At less than a pound it is a lightweight pistol that conceals easily and carries well. The frame is hard anodized black and the slide is natural stainless making for a striking combination. Opt for the Siglite night sights as they are supremely useful in low-light situations. Magazine capacity is just six but autos are easier to reload than revolvers, so a spare magazine will provide extra insurance.

Offered in a wide variety of calibers and styles, the Charter Arms revolver is the type of handgun that will do what you need when you need it done.

COLT MUSTANG

It looks like a 1911, only smaller. The Colt Mustang is the .380 version of the venerable combat classic. Slim and trim, this little pistol brings six rounds of .380 ACP to the fight while remaining concealed and out of the way. The pistol runs on the traditional single-action, cocked-and-locked system using the Colt Series 80 firing system. The Mustang has been around for a while and Colt has made many changes over the years, making the latest versions of this pistol reliable and effective defensive weapons.

RUGER LCRx

What the LCP is to the small auto pistol, the LCRx is to revolvers. The x designation means this revolver carries an external hammer, as opposed to the concealed hammer of the Plain-Jane LCR. The LCRx is rated for +P ammo yet still sports Ruger's modern lightweight cylinder design. The LCRx weighs in at 13.5 ounces, perfect for all-day carry. Shooters who want the option of cocking the hammer for single-action fire have it with this little revolver.

RUGER LCP

Ruger's auto-loading pistols used to be thought of as bulky, clunky and difficult to carry. Not any longer. The LCP is built around the .380 ACP and features a glass-filled nylon frame for lightweight strength. The shrouded hammer offers second-strike capability in the unlikely event of a misfire. With a width of just .82 inches, the LCP nearly disappears in a pocket holster or IWB carry rig. Stainless steel and black nylon may not be the most elegant combination, but this little pistol is a great value for a defensive handgun.
